Introduction to Grizzly GP-1

Your new B-Air Grizzly #GP-1 dryer / air mover has a 1 hp high efficiency motor with the following features:

- · State of the art construction
- · Low 9.8 amps
- · 25 foot power cord
- · 3550 cfm
- · Safety screens on open vents
- · Easy grip carrying handle
- · Swing out kick-stand
- · Safety locks to lock adapter (#ddk)
- · 3 speed switch

Operation/Use



- Carefully place the B-Air Grizzly unit on a stable flat surface during operation.
- B) Use free standing or with attachments The B-Air Grizzly unit can be positioned to aim airflow across flat surfaces or angled in 2 aditional positions. Raise or lower the attached kick stand for height adjustment.
- C) Turn on the switch to the desired speed and make sure the unit is operating correctly.
- D) All dryers / air movers in operation must be monitored at all times.

Storage

Store unit indoors in a clean dry environment to ensure long life and to mainitain unit integrity.

Safety

- 1) Keep children and pets away from unit while in operation and/or plugged in.
- Do not put fingers or other objects in unit while in operation and/or plugged in.
- 3) To avoid electric shock, do not operate in pooled water.
- Unit must be kept dry at all times, including motor, wiring and exterior. If unit becomes wet, thoroughly dry before next operation.
- Only use with a grounded plug and/or extension cord to avoid risk of electrical shock or fire. Remember never to use a power cord showing any kind of damage or wear.
- Make sure the power source is sufficient to meet the requirements of the dryer / air mover.
- To prevent the unit from overheating, keep air intakes clear at all times.
- Clogging or blocking the air intakes could result in a fire or electrical hazard.
- To prevent injury, do not remove any screens or safety guards from the unit.
 Do not operate unit close to any dangerous areas such as explosive gases,
- flammables, heaters or in unventilated environments.

 11) Do not use any form of speed control device as doing so may cause injury or fire.
- Always place dryer / air mover on a smooth and leveled surface for safe operation.
- 13) Do not use unit if damaged.
- 14) Before cleaning or servicing, unplug unit.
- 15) All dryers / air movers in operation must be monitored at all times.
- 16) Do not expose to rain, water or snow.
- Unit must be connected to a GFCI (ground fault circuit interrupter) protected receptacle.

Warning!

All dryers / air movers in operation must be monitored. The use of a 3-prong to 2-prong adapter is prohibited. Only use a 2-prong to 2-prong adapter.

If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

Service

In order to receive service or replacement parts under warranty, you must:

- A. Call for an RMA (Return Merchandise Authorization Number)
- B. Have proof of purchase

Upon inspection, we will advise you of the repairs needed and the cost (if applicable). B-Air will issue repair or replacement parts depending on warranty.

Limited Warranty

Proof of purchase is required on all warranty claims

Warranty covers against defects in material and craftsmanship used under normal intended use to original purchaser for a term of (1) one year from the original date of purchase including parts, labor and 1 way shipping. Housing is covered for a term of (5) five years from the date of the original purchase.

Important!


Warranty does not cover signs of misuse including, but not limited to rough handling, abuse, tampering, improper voltage use and unauthorized maintenance and repairs.

Cords

- 1) Do not use extension cords for outside use.
- Use 3 prong adaptors that are UL and CE approved and not less than 14-3 with ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- 3) Do not use cords that show any kind or wear or damage.
- 4) Cords are not covered by warranty.
